RULES

- Photocopies of the entry form are accepted.
- Entrants must be amateur artists over 60 years of age and living in the United Kingdom.
- The work should have been produced during the last three years and must have been executed after the artist attained the age of 60.
- Work in any medium is accepted, including photography and 3D work. There is no restriction to subject matter.
- Maximum size of original artwork must not exceed 36" x 36" including frame for 2D works, or 36" x 36" x 36" for 3D works.
- If for sale, the price of each work should include a 30% commission to be retained by EAC.
- Entries should be submitted in the form of colour photograph or laser print reproduction, no larger than A4 in size. PLEASE DO NOT SUBMIT FRAMED ORIGINAL WORKS AT THIS FIRST STAGE, ONLY SEND REPRODUCED IMAGES.
- Each entry should be labelled clearly with the title of the work and the entrant's name and address.
- Each entry must be accompanied by the official entry form and appropriate fee. A maximum of 5 entries per artist is allowed.
- All entry fees go towards the administration of the competition and will not be refunded if your work is not selected for exhibition.
- Entries cannot be returned unless a stamped addressed envelope is provided with the appropriate paid postage.
- All artists will be informed of the outcome of their entry by 22 August 2008.
- If selected for exhibition the entry must be submitted in original format and works on paper must be framed.
- Responsibility for damage or loss, however caused, is the responsibility of the artist. EAC cannot be responsible for any works lost or damaged in the post, or when hung in the exhibition.
- The decision of the judging panel shall be final and EAC will not enter into correspondence with entrants or their representatives.
- The copyright remains with the artist, but EAC retains the right to reproduce the works for publicity purposes for the Art Awards and its exhibitions (including its website) in any format in all territories in perpetuity.

ABOUT EAC OVER 60S ART AWARDS

Now in its 15th year, EAC Over 60s Art Awards is a national art competition that aims to encourage and celebrate the talents of older people. All UK based amateur artists over 60 are invited to enter works in any medium - oil, watercolour, charcoal, pastel, pencil, acrylic, etc, 3D work and photography are also welcome. Artists may submit more than one entry (maximum 5 entries per person) and group works are also accepted. Entry is £9 per work.

PRIZES

There will be prizes of at least £250 in each of the following categories:

Landscape/Seascape	Still Life (any medium)
Watercolour	Drawing
Oil	Photography
Portrait (any medium)	3D Work

Angela Farnell Memorial Prize

An additional £1,000 prize will be awarded in memory of the founder of EAC. The prize will be for the best entry from an artist living in sheltered / retirement housing or a care home, or who entered through a day centre. This prize is divided between the artist and their sheltered scheme, care home or day centre.

EXHIBITION

Approximately 100 finalists' works will be included in the EAC Over 60s Art Awards exhibition at the Bankside Gallery, 48 Hopton Street, London, SE1 9JH, from 2 - 7 September 2008. All exhibiting artists will be invited to a Private View of the exhibition on the early evening of Tuesday 2nd September, at which prizes will be awarded to the winners. This year we are delighted to have the support of the journalist and broadcaster Joan Bakewell, who will present the prizes at this year's Private View.

Works can be offered for sale at the exhibition and exhibitors will also have the opportunity to accept commissions for new work. The price of each work should include a 30% commission to be retained by EAC.

HOW TO ENTER

Initial submissions should be photographs or laser prints of your work, see rules overleaf. Complete the attached entry form and send with images and relevant entry fees to the exhibition organisers, Parker Harris Partnership, at the address below. At this first stage please do not send original works, only send reproduced images. Please note that all entry fees go towards the administration of the competition and will not be refunded if your work is not selected for exhibition.

First round of judging will take place soon after the deadline date for entries, and all artists will be informed of the judges' decisions by the 22 August 2008. If selected for exhibition, the organisers will contact all finalists with details of arrangements for sending original works to London for the exhibition. A second round of judging to select prize winners will take place once the exhibition is on display.
