- Travel for 1 mile and turn left onto Southmoor Road

Directions from M60 heading east

- Leave the M60 at Junction 5
- Join the A5103 direction Wythenshawe
- Travel to the M56 junction, do not join the M56, leave by the slip road to join the A560 Altrincham Road
- Travel for 1 mile and turn left onto Southmoor Road.
