Residents are enabled to personalise their individual bungalow with their own furnishings, however all fully wheelchair accessible bungalows are fitted/equipped with the following:

- \* Electric door entry and locking system
- \* Television (satellite available at additional cost); telephone point for private line at additional cost
- \* Living space to include a kitchenette with hob/oven, fridge/freezer, washing machine and microwave
- \* Multiple electrical sockets at accessible heights
- \* Overhead hoist from bedroom to en suite shower/wet room
- \* Bedroom with bed, bedside light, wardrobe, chest of drawers, bedside cabinet, table & two reclining chairs.
- \* Wet room with drop-down shower tray, wash hand basin and lavatory
- \* Vinyl flooring suitable for wheelchair manoeuvring
- \* Lockable safe for personal belongings
- \* Smoke alarm
- \* Exterior lighting
- \* Patio area
- \* Accessible height windows
- \* Nurse call system



### **Gardens and Grounds**

Accessible parking is available close to each bungalow for residents and visitors. The grounds, with landscaped quiet areas, are maintained for communal use and all pathways are wheelchair accessible.

### **Daily Activities & Services In The Bungalows**

Following assessment and admission each resident has an agreed Care plan reviewed at monthly intervals. As a general guide, the care plan includes elements of daily living as listed below.

#### **Personal Care**

Provided under supervision of skilled and experienced Registered Nurses with Personal Assistants delivering personal care and assistance with daily living activities. Each resident will be allocated a Named Registered Nurse and a Personal Assistant as their key worker. It is our aim to have all our Personal Assistants holding Vocational Qualification in Care either at level two or three.

#### **Nutritional Care**

All bungalow kitchenettes are equipped for the provision of meals. Registered Nurses and Personal Assistants assist in providing nourishment and fluids.

#### **Therapy Treatment and Psycho-Social Care**

Following initial assessment OT/Physiotherapy needs can be supported at the request of the Registered Nurse. Residents are encouraged and enabled to pursue their own hobbies and leisure interests.

#### **Maintenance & Housekeeping**

A planned maintenance programme ensures all regulations are upheld. All breakdowns are repaired in a timely fashion to ensure the continued safety of all residents. Personal Assistants will ensure that personal laundry is washed and the bungalows are kept clean and tidy.

**About The Chaseley Trust:** The Charity formed in 1946 to care for paralysed War Veterans, and while now caring for people from all walks of life, Chaseley still prioritises ex-service personnel when places become available. The main Home in South Cliff provides residential, respite and day care for people with many forms of severe physical disability, along with outpatient therapy services with specialized equipment for wheelchair users, and rehabilitation programmes.
