Harbledown House

Harbledown House consists of 33 bedsits and 3 one bedroom flats, access to all floors via lifts or stairs. Ample parking at the front of the building.

Communal rooms include day centre, TV Lounge, laundry, foot clinic and hairdressing salon. Weekly events and lunch clubs, with socials are held throughout the year.

Shops and G.P surgeries are within walking distance and the town centre is close by.

Call Centre

All of our sheltered housing schemes, semi sheltered housing and community lifelines are linked to the Invicta telecare centre.

This centre is operational 24 hours a day, 365 days a year.

When an emergency call is activated from your lifeline the telecare centre can view your details on a computer screen and will be able to talk to you to ascertain your difficulty. They will then get in touch with your contacts or the emergency Services as appropriate.
