Our sheltered housing is specially designed for people over 55 who are looking for complete independence but within easy access to support when it's needed.

We have been providing attractive comfortable homes for older people since 1965, and work hard to make sure that all schemes are very much part of the local community.

As well as the support we provide, we can also provide access to services from the local council, health care providers and others that can offer leisure services and social activities.

Who is Ridings Court for?

Our Equality and Diversity policy recognises that all people are different and must be treated as Individuals. We are committed to equal opportunities and welcome applications from all sections of the community.

We welcome applications from single people and couples
You can apply for sheltered housing at Ridings Court if you are
55years [or younger if you have a physical or other disability] and
are assessed as requiring the type of support services that we
can offer.

Support could mean advice about finances and benefits or prompting, life skills e.g. cleaning, shopping and liaising with other agencies on your behalf.

Our residents include people with minimum support needs and people with different degrees of disability and age related health problems such as mobility, memory problems, visual or hearing impairment, or social isolation.

SCHEME FACILITIES

Ridings Court provides pleasant one bedroom accommodation in the popular Crawcrook area. The property is ideally situated within a short bus journey from local Shopping Centre offering excellent local amenities. The fully independent centrally heated apartments benefit from a lift service, entry phone security system and other communal facilities including Laundry and Residents' Lounge. Residents can also benefit from the use of a guest apartment for family and friends.

Accommodation, which is available for rent, briefly comprises:

Entrance Hallway: From the front door, the entrance hallway

provides access to the Lounge, Bathroom

and Bedroom.

Lounge: The room benefits from a double glazed

window, TV and telephone point.

Kitchen: Some has a double glazed window and is

fitted with a range of wall and floor units, roll edge work surfaces, inset sink and drainer unit and extensive kitchen

appliances including electric cooker and

refrigerator.

Bedroom: With double glazed window, walk in

wardrobe

Bathroom/WC: Comprising of either a panelled bath/or

disabled bathing facilities/or a shower. A wash hand basin, tiling to walls and a low

level WC.

External: The property enjoys the benefit of

extensive landscaped gardens for the use of residents, maintained by the landlord,

and a private car park.

Support: We encourage residents to maintain an

independent lifestyle; however a 24 hour support service is available if required.
