**Type(s):** Care home with nursing.

**Conditions cared for:** Older people generally / People with a mental disability / People with dementia.

**Care period:** Longer stay / Short stay and respite / Trial visits.

**Accommodation:** This home accommodates 48 residents in 44 single and 2 shared rooms. It is a converted building with a garden, and was registered in 1994. Overnight visitors can usually be accommodated.

**Accessibility:** bus stop 250 yards; shop 250 yards; post office 250 yards; town centre 2 mile(s); GP 1 mile(s); social centre 250 yards;.

**Lifestyle:** Residents may bring their own furniture and choose their room decoration. There is a lot of flexibility about meals. Activities are arranged daily. There are opportunities to pursue hobbies.

**Cost:** Not available. Local Authority rates accepted. NHS Continuing Care Funding rate accepted.

**Manager's description:** The Willows Care Home has two units which provide nursing care for Elderly Mentally Infirm and for over 40 years of age with mental health needs. It is situated at Perthcelyn, Mountain Ash, on the bus route between Aberdare and Pontypridd/Cardiff.

The Willows offers breathtaking views of the lower end of the Cynon Valley from all day areas and safe garden area with a patio. The unusual purpose built Mountain Top Home has a bus stop, Post Office and local convenience stores on its doorstep. It has the capacity to accommodate 24 individuals with one double option in each unit. Consideration is given to both long term alternative life style needs and respite needs. To enable residents to adopt an alternative life style culture they are encouraged to personalise their own rooms.
