**Type(s):** Care home with nursing.

**Conditions cared for:** Older people generally / People with physical difficulties.

**Care period:** Longer stay / Short stay and respite / Day care / Trial visits / Home care.

**Accommodation:** This home accommodates 50 residents in 40 single and 5 shared rooms (45 en suite). It is purpose built and has a garden, and was registered in 1996. Overnight visitors can usually be accommodated.

**Accessibility:** The home is in an urban location. bus stop 0.5 mile(s); shop 0.5 mile(s); post office 1 mile(s); GP 0.5 mile(s);.

**Lifestyle:** Residents may bring their own furniture and choose their room decoration. There is a lot of flexibility about meals. Residents can bring their pet. Activities are arranged daily. There are opportunities to pursue hobbies and to help with gardening.

**Cost:** Not available. Local Authority rates accepted. NHS Continuing Care Funding rate accepted.

**Manager's description:** Anville Court is conveniently located in the pleasant residential suburb of Penn, near Wolverhampton. It is within walking distance of local shops and on a main bus route. This attractive purpose-built home has been designed and equipped to meet the needs of elderly residents. Bright and welcoming, it has four spacious lounges, one with a balcony and one with a conservatory. There are two dining rooms, which overlook a pretty, level garden with a sun terrace and shaded gazebo. All the bedrooms are furnished to a high standard and all have en-suite facilities. Daily activities include flower arranging, handicrafts, sewing, baking and gardening. Anville Court also offers care to younger physically disabled people, those who have had strokes and those requiring palliative and terminal care.
