**Accommodation:** This home accommodates 120 residents in 120 single rooms (120 en suite). It is purpose built and has a garden, and was registered in 2004.

**Accessibility:** The home is in an urban location. Bus stop 250 yards; shop 250 yards; post office 1 mile(s); GP 250 yards;.

**Lifestyle:** Residents may bring their own furniture and choose their room decoration. There is a lot of flexibility about meals. Activities are arranged daily. There are opportunities to pursue hobbies and to help with gardening.

**Cost:** Not available. Local Authority rates accepted. NHS Continuing Care Funding rate accepted.

**Manager's description:** Elderslie is situated in the residential area of Elderslie in Paisley, just 10 miles from Glasgow city centre. Local amenities are close by and the home is on the main bus route into Paisley, Glasgow and the Clyde coast. This modern two-storey home has been built to meet the needs of residents and comprises of four units. Two provide nursing care and two nursing dementia care. Each has a choice of five lounges, including a smoking area, a residents kitchen and two homely dining rooms which provide places for residents to relax and entertain guests. The home also boasts a landscaped garden and patio area complete with wooden gazebo and seating area. All the bedrooms are single occupancy, and some have patio access to the secure gardens. A varied and entertaining social calendar includes daily activities, arts and crafts, reading in the library, visiting entertainers and trips to local places of interest.
