



Care Options is growing

Nearly 3,000 care homes in England are now part of Care Options. Homes in Wales have recently received their Care Options questionnaires, and Scotland and Northern Ireland will follow shortly.

The table below shows the number of participating homes by English county at 8th September 2003.

Our map illustrates the geographical spread. Participation is particularly strong in Lancashire, North Yorkshire and Leeds in the North and the whole of the South coast, from Cornwall to Kent. Derbyshire, Gloucestershire and Essex are all progressing well.
