

EAC National Housing for Older People Awards

Each year EAC celebrates the best examples of housing for later life.

All housing schemes that have used the EAC *Resident Consultation Service* (RCS) with its popular card game are automatically entered for the current EAC Housing Awards. Our IT systems will select the winning schemes, and allocate the bronze, silver and gold awards in 11 categories (mainly size categories).

The main Awards celebrations are occasions greatly enjoyed by 300 guests, half of them being the residents of the winning schemes.

Previous Awards have been held at Lords Cricket Ground (2010), Ascot Racecourse (2011), Legal & General head office, City of London (2012), National Motorcycle Museum, Birmingham (2013) and Doncaster Racecourse (2014)

Aims of the Awards

- Publicly celebrate the best specialist housing for older people
- Engage thousands of residents in identifying what contributes to quality of life in traditional and emerging models of specialist housing provision
- Ensure that older people, families and carers have access to the best possible information
- Help shape the future of housing in later life
