A bus stop is within a few minutes walk with a regular service to Maidstone town centre. A post office and general store is nearby with a home delivery service.

Call Centre

All of our sheltered housing schemes, semi sheltered housing and community lifelines are linked to the Invicta telecare centre.

This centre is operational 24 hours a day, 365 days a year.

When an emergency call is activated from your lifeline the telecare centre can view your details on a computer screen and will be able to talk to you to ascertain your difficulty. They will then get in touch with your contacts or the emergency Services as appropriate.
